

A ruck is formed when there is at least 1 player from each team competing over the ball.

A 'bridger' over the ball, creates an offside line but does not form a ruck.

Jackal's are permitted in line with the normal laws of rugby (except P4, no jackal)

Coaches & referees should encourage players to 'Tackle below the ball'.

Tackle Guide


Above sternum = penalty

Waist to sternum, Ref "work to get low!" If they do, play on. Rip or cause knock-on = penalty to attack

Below waist = play on.
